



## A CHRISTMAS BLESSING TO ALL!

### A. WHAT IS YOUR SPHERE OF INFLUENCE?

Take time and make a list writing down every address of every individual that you know...family or friends. It does not matter whether they are saved or unsaved. God has placed these people in your life for a reason. May we grasp the revelation that eternity hangs in the balance.

There was a time where people used to send Christmas cards. Social media, Facebook, and email communication has dwindled the number where people send out a personal communication through the post office or snail mail. Consider doing it different this year!

### B. SUGGESTED OPENING OF YOUR TESTIMONY CHRISTMAS LETTER

The opening paragraph should be short where common ground is shared with that person. A pastor had suggested a good opening line to use would be – “What is the greatest thing that has impacted you in your life so far?” Some may say it is a job they obtained, maybe a marriage to this special person, and inheritance, etc - but YOU can say it was coming to the Lord Jesus Christ and recognizing Him as Savior.

### C. POWER OF YOUR PERSONAL TESTIMONY

Everyone has a personal testimony that can have an impact on anyone who will read or listen to it. Life experiences are powerful! As you send these out we have no idea what individuals are going through in their personal lives. We had each experienced a salvation process and others need to know how you came to the Lord. WRITE OUT YOUR TESTIMONY! Along with your prayers, many will be impacted by how you came to Christ.

*“Then I heard a loud voice saying in heaven, “Now salvation, and strength, and the kingdom of our God, and the power of His Christ have come, for the accuser of our brethren, who accused them before our God day and night, has been cast down. **And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of their testimony, and they did not love their lives to the death.**” (Rev. 12:10-11)*

### D. CLOSE OF YOUR LETTER

Give a Christmas Blessing over their family and share how you are praying for and thinking about them. Of course sign it...and be always willing to speak with and pray for them!

### SUGGESTIONS

2. Purchase Christmas letter head and print off your testimony and use a copy machine. You may want to insert it in a Christmas card or just send in an envelope. Spare no expense!
3. Take the list of people you compiled and PRAY for them to receive Christ or grow in Him!
