STEP 1: Ask Poll Worker to see printout of precinct results or make a copy for you. Per MCL 168.807, they must make available to you.

MCL 168.807

Immediately after the canvass has been completed, the canvasser, starting by total number of votes received by each person voted for in each precinct for any office and the number of votes for and the number of votes against any proposed constitutional amendment or other submitted proposition, shall so make available to interested persons who may be present.

STEP 2: Take a photo (if short) or video (if long) of precinct results

STEP 3: Open web browser and navigate to electioneyes.us or scan QR Code below



STEP 4: For each precinct, enter data requested in form and hit submit →
